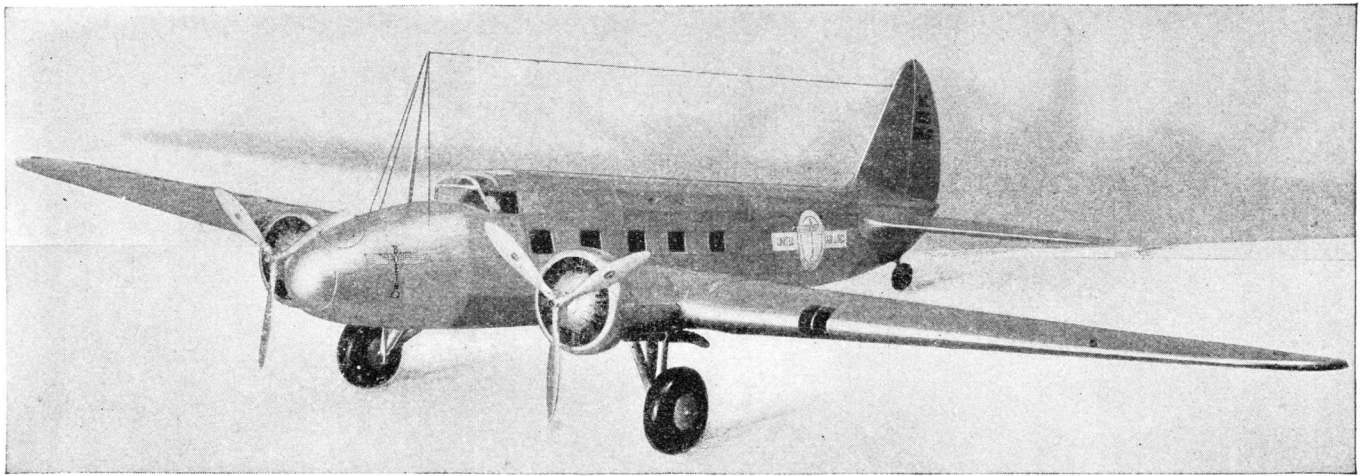
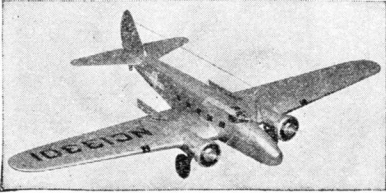


# Authentic Cee Dee Model of the World's Most Outstanding Commercial Airplane . . . BOEING 247



Here are two realistic views of the new 3/8" scale Cleveland-Designed model of the already world famous Boeing 247 type commercial plane which cruises at 180 m.p.h. over many air-lines throughout the United States. (The one above is a model of one in the

Boeing division of the United Air Lines. Information may be gathered by any builder for making the particular line insignia in which he is most interested. They are not supplied with the Kit.)

This beautiful model is capable of exceptionally good flights, for flights of over 250 feet were quite easily obtained with the same model pictured here. We were about as surprised after testing this ship as we were after the Laird Super-Solution was designed. Honestly, we did not think much about its flying ability, although we did know it would make some flights, but after testing it, it flew beyond all expectation. In many cases it reached an altitude of 40 feet, looking just like the big ship itself, only for the fact that the wheels do not retract (which is impossible because of the motor being so low in the wings). Span is 55 1/2", length 38 3/4", weight 16 oz. Colored all silver.

Powered with rubber strands, and made in the orthodox C-D manner except for the larger structural

members such as wing beams which are of the girder type and generally of balsa, paper, music wire, and furnished with standard Cleveland dopes and cements. Motor sticks are removable so when displayed, it looks like an exhibition model.

The Kit comes complete, all materials necessary, including partly finished nose block, ready furnished cowls, completed wheels, stout axle material to withstand the severe shocks (the model weighs approximately 16 oz. ready for flying, you know), all the dopes necessary and extra strong covering paper.

Complete Kit SF-35, as described above and including two sheets of drawings (4 panels 17" x 44"), containing every bit of information necessary for building the model, shipped anywhere in the U. S. by express (prohibited by mail because of the large quantity of inflammable liquids, dopes, cements, etc.), shipping charges collect (wt. not over 10 lbs.) — for only **\$6.50**

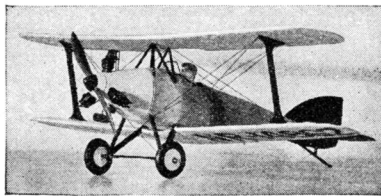

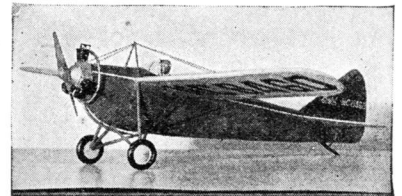


### LINCOLN Sport Plane
