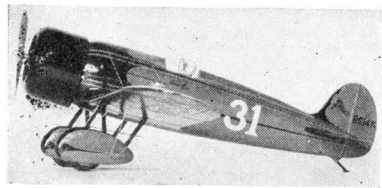

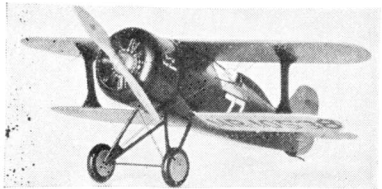

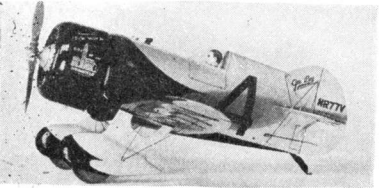
**★ THOMPSON TROPHY WINNERS ★**



**1929: Travel Air Mystery Ship**  
This beautiful ship in 1929 started a new era in landplane racer design and through many requests by those who wished to head their Thompson Trophy lineup with this kit, it was thoroughly redesigned. Recommended for exhibition contests. Span 21 3/4", red with black scalloping, green trim. Kit SF-2..... **2.95**



**1930: Laird "Solution" Racer**  
Charles "Speed" Holman won the Thompson trophy race of 1930 in this biplane. Model is of recent C-D design and employs the best type of model construction. Recommended for those who want an attractive fast flying model. Span 15 7/8". Laird gold and black. Kit SF-46..... **2.50**



**1931: Bayles' Gee-Bee Racer**  
This stubby little plane won the '31 Thompson trophy race. Had a very short fuselage which made it very maneuverable flying the pylons. Our model is redesigned and the most accurate model of its type on the market. Wing span 17 3/4". Yellow and black. SF-17..... **1.95**

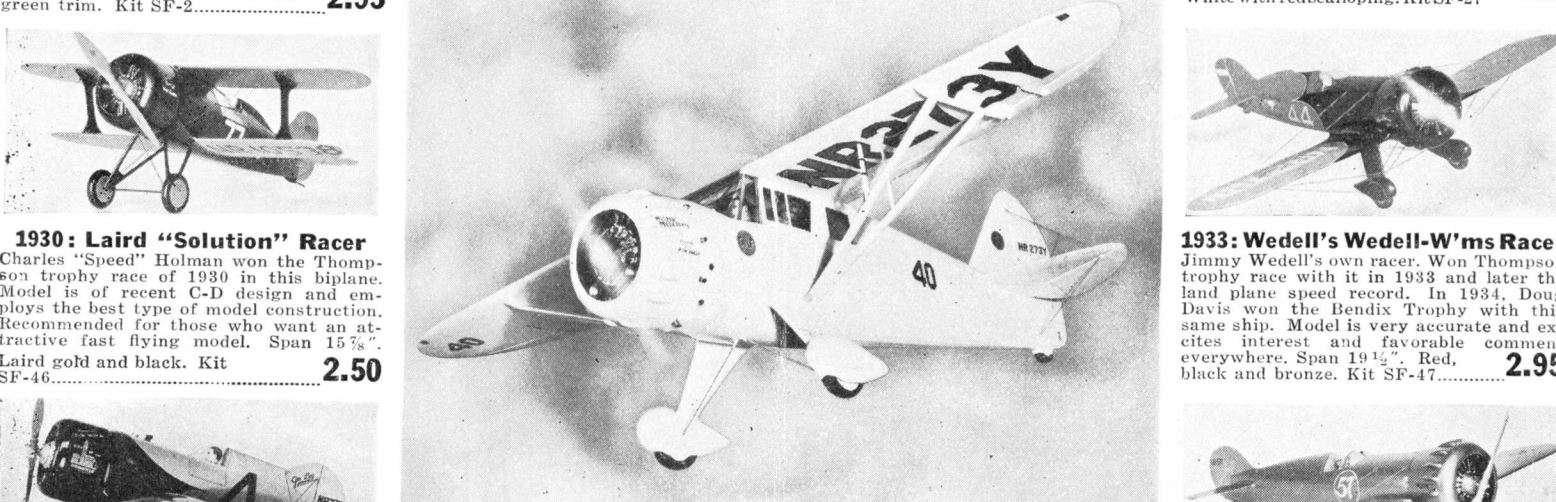

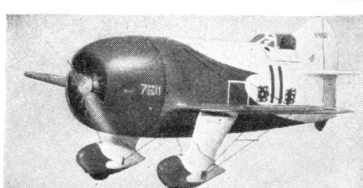

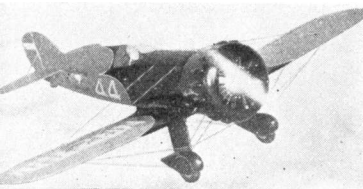


**1935 WINNER OF THE THOMPSON TROPHY "MISTER MULLIGAN"**

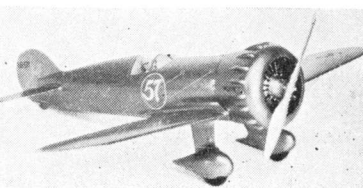
This plane was reputed to be the fastest cabin plane made at the time it won the Thompson speed classic and it proved itself by flying over 220 M.P.H., winning the coveted trophy for 1935. Model exterior as detailed as the prototype and all white with gold lettering and black trim. Material supplied for both authentic motor with cowl and dummy fronts—take your choice. Balsa, not paper covered, where necessary to simulate plywood or metal. No other Mulligan will ever be like it for your Thompson lineup. **1932: Doolittle's Gee-Bee Racer**  
The daring stubby design that took first place in Thompson Trophy Race of 1932. Major "Jimmy" Doolittle flew the course at an average of 252 M.P.H. which is still the Thompson "high" record. Make this unusual flying model. Span 18 3/4". White with red scalloping. Kit SF-27..... **2.50**



**1933: Wedell's Wedell-W's Racer**  
Jimmy Wedell's own racer. Won Thompson trophy race with it in 1933 and later the land plane speed record. In 1934, Doug Davis won the Bendix Trophy with this same ship. Model is very accurate and excites interest and favorable comment everywhere. Span 19 1/2". Red, black and bronze. Kit SF-47..... **2.95**



**1934: Turner's Wedell-W's Racer**  
Capt. Roscoe Turner with this ship won the '33 Bendix race and '34 Thompson race. Plane holds record for crossing the U. S. both ways. Forced out of first place in '35 Thompson race due to broken oil line. Span 19 1/2". Wedell-Wil- liams gold. Kit SF-48..... **2.95**
